Participants: The contest is open to all middle school students (grades 6-8) in the Tulsa Metro area.

Essay Length: 350 – 500 words

- Words must be counted and noted on the title page
- Dates count as one word
- Information on the title page is not counted in the word count
- Entries should be typed
- Entries must be double-spaced, 12 pt. font
- Provide a list of sources to give credit for the information

Title Page: The title page must include the essay title, contestant's full name, grade, school, sponsoring teacher (if applicable), phone number and email address of parent, and number of words in the essay.

1 st Place: \$250.00	2 nd Place: \$225.00	3 rd Place: \$200.00
4 th Place \$175.00	5 th Place: \$150.00	

Judging Criteria: An example of the rubric used by judges is on Page 2.

Note to Teachers: All entries will be accepted for consideration.
However, schools **MUST** identify the five essays they consider their best.
Previous 1st place winners are ineligible to enter.

Judging Criteria

Content (1-50 pts)

A	Essay shows originality and creativity	
B	Essay clearly expresses the main idea	
C	Essay includes facts, examples, reasons or specific details to support and elaborate on the main idea	

Organization (1-20 pts)

A	Paragraphs show logical development	
B	Paragraphs contain varied sentence structure and appropriate transitions	
C	Paragraphs show unity of ideas and expression	

Mechanics (1-20 pts)

A	Mechanical and grammatical errors do not distract from the main idea or content	
B	Word count does not exceed 500 words	
C	Essay is typed and double spaced
